





**Sustainable Materials for a new Architectural Practice – Entering a circular economy**

The department is very pleased to have won the award with its proposal for a visiting professorship on the topic of "Sustainable Materials for a new Architectural Practice - Entering a circular economy". ## **Research - Prof. Dirk Hebel Sustainable Construction**

MycoTree is nominated for the Beazley Design of the Year 2018 Award. #BeazleyDesignsoftheYear

MycoTree is a spatial branching structure made out of load-bearing mycelium components. Its geometry was designed using 3D graphic statics, keeping the weak material in compression only. Its complex nodes were grown in digitally fabricated moulds.

Utilising only mycelium and bamboo, the structure represents a provocative vision of how we may move beyond the mining of our construction materials from the earth's crust to their cultivation and urban growth; the potential to propose an alternative to established, structural materials for a more sustainable building industry.“
